The novel is composed of a series of nested stories-within-stories, gradually revealing the story of Melmoth's life. The novel offers social commentary on early-19th-century England, and denounces Roman Catholicism in favour of the virtues of Protestantism. John Melmoth, a student in Dublin, visits his dying uncle. He finds a portrait of a mysterious ancestor called Melmoth; the portrait is dated 1646. At his uncle s funeral, John is told an old family story about a stranger called Stanton who arrived looking for Melmoth the Traveller decades earlier.A manuscript left by Stanton describes his first finding Melmoth laughing at the sight of two lovers who have...
